Hi! This pattern came to me one day, when I was bored and I decided to just crochet something! Make sure to flip the body, part 1 and 2, over after you fasten off. Hope you enjoy the pattern and good luck!

Materials: White yarn Colored yarn(s) (any color except white) Stuffing Crochet hook depending on yarn size Tapestry needle

Notes (important): If you are using safety eyes, insert them between round 4 or 5, about 4 stitches apart. Body (Part 1 and 2) - white yarn Tentacles - Whatever color(s) you want

Body (Part 1): (Please read notes if you are using safety eyes.) Magic ring and chain 1 Round 1: SC x 6 (6) Round 2: INC x 6 (12) Round 3: INC x 12 (24) Round 4 - 6: SC x 24 (24) Fasten off and put aside.

Body (Part 2): Magic ring and chain 1 Round 1: SC x 6 (6) Round 2: INC x 6 (12) Round 3: INC x 12 (24) Round 4: SC x 24 (24) Fasten off



Tentacles (However many as you want, 10 tentacles recommended):

Chain 13 and SC in 2nd chain from hook Row 1: SC x 12 Fasten off, leaving a tail about 2 or 3 inches.



This is what 1 of my tentacles look like.

Putting together everything:

Take one tentacle and pick a place in the body (part 2). Put the crochet hook in the place that you want it and "grab" the tails of the tentacle. Pull the tails through the body (part 2). Same way with the other tentacles.



Make sure the tentacles are not too bunched together and that they have some space between them. This is what it should look like after you put in all of the tentacles. Put a knot at the end of the tentacles after you put them in.



After you have put all of the tentacles in the body (part 2), cut a long piece of the white yarn and grab your tapestry needle. Stitch the body (part 1 and 2) together. Keep doing this halfway around the body (part 1 and 2). When it is halfway, stuff the body and continue stitching around the body. If you didn't use safety eyes, embroider the eyes and you are finished! If you want the "Birth Certificate" of the jellyfish you made, PM me on Ravelry. My username is CrochetQueen2129.
