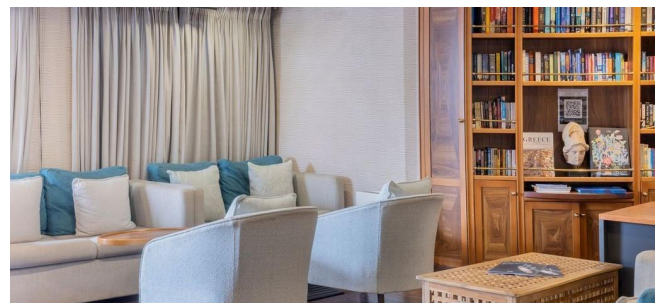

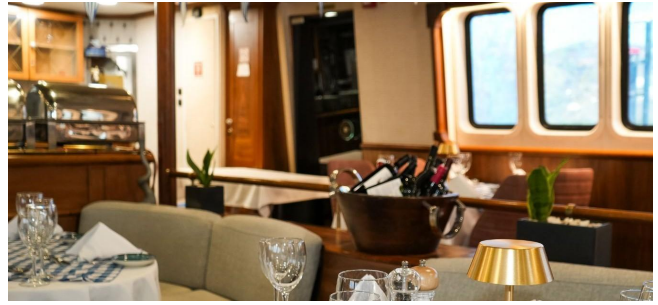

Cabin amenities

The official vessel information lists individually controlled air-conditioning, ensuite shower, hairdryer, flat-screen television, mini-fridge, safe, internal telephone and central music/public-address system. Category A cabins have windows; Categories B and C have portholes.

Cabin photographs are representative rather than cabin-number-specific. The binding allocation reference is the supplier bedding table reproduced in full on pages 9–10.

Connecting suite opportunity

Cabins 3 and 5 can be opened internally to create a two-room arrangement with one double cabin and one twin cabin. It remains two cabins and should be confirmed for the final rooming list.

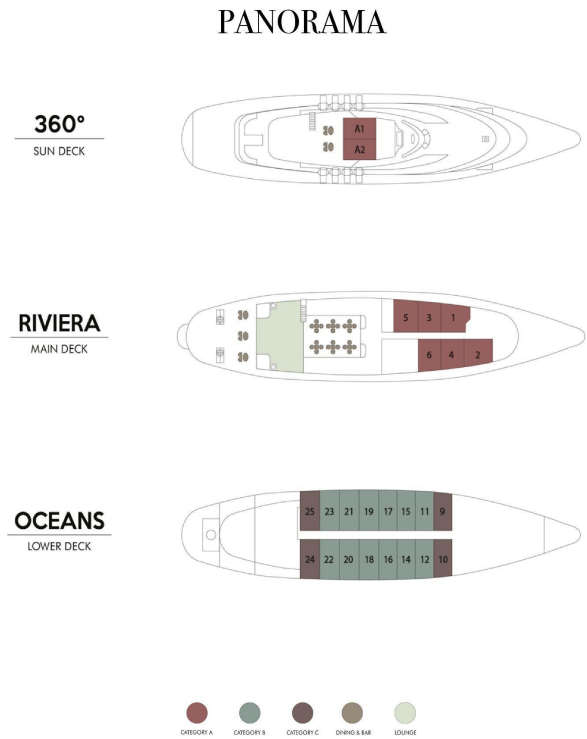

How to read the plan

- 360° / Sun Deck: Category A cabins A1 and A2, plus open deck space.
- Riviera / Main Deck: Category A cabins 1–6 alongside dining, lounge and social areas.
- Oceans / Lower Deck: Categories B and C, cabins 9–25. Cabin number 13 is not used.
- Cabin colour indicates category; the bedding tables remain the controlling allocation reference.
