Frequently Asked Questions

SEASONAL QUESTIONS

Are there any seasonal camping sites left for 2025?

If you are interested in seasonally camping with us, it is best to get your information by calling us at 419-433-4118. We typically book up in the fall for the following season. Give us a call and get on our waiting list.

Are there any seasonal marina docks left for 2025?

Yes! Call 419-433-4118 to make a reservation for a seasonal dock.

How do I book a seasonal site for 2025?

First, please make sure you're on the site request list. You can get your name on the list by calling 419-433-4118. Deposits are due from our current seasonal campers on August 1st, once deposits are collected we will know what sites are available. From there, we will begin calling down the request list. Once calls begin it is first come, first serve with a deposit of half of the site cost in order to hold a site.

What are your seasonal site amenities?

Seasonal sites include only the site, a gravel pad, water, and electric hook up. Site holders are responsible for setting up an account to be billed for their own electric through <u>Ohio Edison</u>. Riverfront sites allow the site holder the option to build or place a dock off their site at no charge, however, those docks are not provided. We also offer <u>marina docks</u>, a <u>honey wagon service</u> (sewer on a select few sites), 24/7 campground access, <u>scheduled activities</u>, <u>evening entertainment</u>, a campground store, and many other <u>campground amenities</u>.

What is the cost for additional adults or children on a seasonal site?

Additional adults are \$100 and additional children are \$50 for the entire season.

OVERNIGHT CAMPING QUESTIONS

How can I book an overnight site?

Reservations can be made over the phone, just give us a call at 419-433-4118. We only offer overnight camping May 1st- October 10th.

Can you tell me your availability?

Call our office at 419-433-4118 for any availability questions.

What are your overnight site amenities?

Every RV/tent site now includes a gravel pad, water, electric hook up, a picnic table, and a fire ring. We also have many campground amenities such as a campground store, a honey wagon service, a dump station, playground, scheduled <u>activities and entertainment</u>, and much, much <u>more</u>.

What is the cost for additional adults or children on an overnight site?

\$5 per person per night for those age 5 and older.

Do you have boat rentals?

How far are you from Kalahari?

We are about a 15-20 minute drive to Kalahari.

How far are you from Cedar Point?

We are about a 25 minute drive to Cedar Point.

How far are you from Summit Motorsports Park?

We are about a 20 minute drive to Summit Motorsports Park.

Do you have sewer?

A few seasonal sites have sewer, however, none of our overnight camping sites have sewer. We do have a dump station on our grounds and offer a Honey Wagon service for either the season or on a one-time/need basis. See our pricing here in the Honey Wagon section.

Can we have campfires?

Absolutely! What's camping without a cozy campfire to sit around?! We ask that all fires are kept within the fire rings provided on your site.

Do you have a pool?

No, we don't have a pool on site, however we do have a <u>swimming lake</u> guarded by a certified lifeguard on warm, summer weekend days.

How many people does your site costs cover?

Our site price includes two adults, two children. Adults are those aged 18 and older (regardless of whether they are still in high school). Children are those aged 5 and older. Children 4 and under are free and will not be counted toward the number of children you have camping with you. Both overnight and seasonal sites are limited to six people and up to two dogs.

What are your quiet hours?

11 PM - 7 AM

Can I fish in the river?

Absolutely! Fishing licenses are required and can be obtained online here.

Are adult beverages allowed at the campground?

Yes. We are a family campground, but beer is sold in the store Monday-Sunday.

Do you have WiFi?

Yes! However, this WiFi is through a 3rd party and there are some small fees associated with the access. See more information here.

Do you allow golf carts?

Yes! However, they must be electric. We do not allow gas golf carts in the park and we have to have proof of insurance upon arrival. There is also a \$10.00 one time fee to register it with us. The registration is good for our entire season.

What is your cancellation policy?

There is a five (5) day cancellation policy for a full refund for overnight sites. If you call five (5) days before your stay with us, we offer a full refund. Within those five (5) days there is no refund, but we can always move your reservation to a later date in our current season.
