

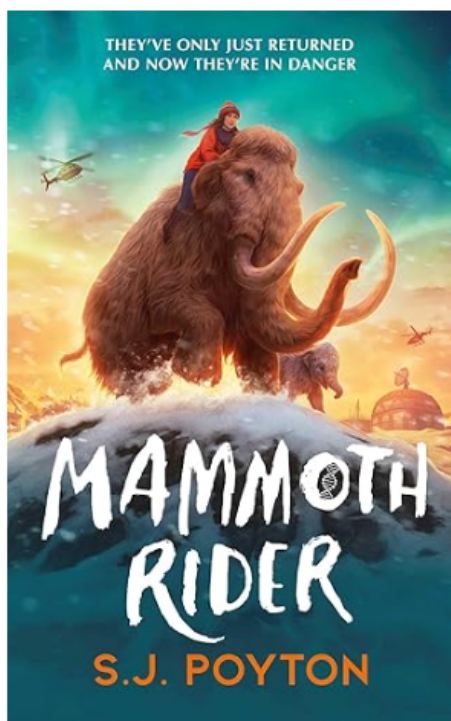
Author visit to FPJS- S. J Poyton- Monday 9th March
