Call to Order

a. Vice President Bobbi Miller called the meeting to order at 5:30pm

Approval of Agenda

Motion made by Young

Motion seconded by Rabe to approve the agenda.

Voting: Unanimously Approved. 5-0 Motion carried.

Pledge of Allegiance and Mission Statement – Bobbi Miller read the Mission Statement

Regular Business – Consent Agenda

A motion was made by Slaymaker, seconded by Young to approve the consent agenda: Minutes of the October 19th, 2022 meeting; financial reports, payment of bills for the month of November

Unanimously Approved. Motion carried.

The board discussed the continuation of the Instruction Support Levy. Administration discussed with the board what the levy was and how Iowa Valley has used it for many years. A motion was made by Young, seconded by Rabe, to approve the resolution to consider continued participation in the instruction support program. Roll call vote. Rabe aye, Hall aye, Young aye, Slaymaker aye, Miller aye. Motion carried.

The board discussed that with the approval of the resolution, a public hearing will be held at the December board meeting.

The board continued discussion on holding a bond referendum for \$10.3 in building improvements. Jake Berg, from SiteLogic, discussed with the board there would be the following improvements at the Jr./Sr. High School: Asbestos abatement, ceiling replacement, lighting/LED installation, fire alarm system upgrades, roof replacements, main entry remodel, restroom upgrades for ADA compliance, renovate Ag/Ind Tech classrooms, tuckpointing, new main electrical system.

The following improvements at the elementary would be: tuckpointing, LED lighting installation, roof replacements.

The board discussed roof warranties and requesting for 30 year warranties.

Administration discussed with the board that a petition will need to be presented to the citizens of lowa Valley to sign. The petition would need to have signatures of 25% of the votes cast at the last board election. The signatures will be verified and then, if appropriate, the petition would be presented to the board in December to call for the election. The board discussed looking to have the election on March 7th, 2023.

The board agreed to proceed with the project.

Administration discussed entering into a sharing agreement with HLV for Girls wrestling. There will be some expenses that will be billed to HLV. A motion was made by Rabe, seconded by Young to approve the Girls Wrestling Sharing Agreement with HLV. Motion carried.

Administration informed the board of an open enrollment application from Danny Rios in from Iowa City.

A motion was made by Young, seconded by Slaymaker to adjourn at 6:45 pm. Unanimously approved. Motion carried.
