**Part 1** Ask child to share about his/her reading. What's it about, what do you like about it, etc...Ask if they have any questions about what they are reading or would like help with a strategy to use. Listen to them read. AFFIRM what you notice they are doing well in their reading.

Part 2 TEACH: Based on the above conversation or on "said" goals, teach to the specific need of each child. Ask them to try it- check back later
