Finalists in the Global Final received an all-expenses-paid trip to Guyana's Diamond Distillery, home of El Dorado Rum and the last remaining Distillery in Guyana. This opportunity allows them to experience Guyanese culture and heritage before presenting their final creations to a panel of esteemed judges.

Chairman of the DDL, Mr. Komal Samaroo expressed his excitement to host the competition in Guyana, the home of El Dorado Rum. "The Global Cocktail Finals is a platform to celebrate not only the incredible talent of these bartenders but also the rich history and craftsmanship of Demerara Distillers Ltd. and El Dorado rums that have been passed down for several generations," said Mr. Samaroo.

The Global Finals of the El Dorado Rum Heritage Cocktail Competition will be judged by industry experts Sandrae Lawrence, co-founder of the award-winning publication The Cocktail Lovers; Sly Augustin from Trailer Happiness; and Sharon Sue-Hang Baksh, Master Blender at Demerara Distillers Limited.

- i. They must recreate their cocktail from the regional heats.
- ii. Whilst in Guyana they must develop a second serve using ingredients from the local market. This cocktail must be made using one of the El Dorado Single Still SKU's
- a. El Dorado Single Still Enmore (EHP)
- b. El Dorado Single Still Port Mourant (PM)
- c. El Dorado Single Still Versailles (VSG)
