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High school students interested in pursuing a job shadow experience should follow these steps:

1. Work with your School Counselor, Work-Based Learning Supervisor (MOC), or Work Experience Coordinator (WEC) and have them reach out to:

3. Work with Teresa Bushman to schedule a time to observe.

Here are some additional considerations:

- You are responsible to arrange your own transportation to and from the job shadow
- Arrive on time and communicate if a conflict arises
- Plan ahead. Allow one to two weeks to arrange a job shadow placement
- The job shadow placement will be at the discretion of Keystone and may not be in the school or district you currently attend.
- Bring your photo ID.
- Please dress appropriately for the job shadow.
- Please turn the ringer on your cell phone off and keep the phone stored away during the job shadow.
