	Today's topic is "The cscratch1 crash". Cori had a major outage during the last two weeks. We're still investigating the root cause but the trigger conditions appear to relate to files with a very large stripe count. We'll give an

	overview of the crash, the conditions that we think triggered it and the impacts users might be seeing. We'll also have some Q&A with NERSC's Doug Jacobsen (Computational Systems Group), Glenn Lockwood (Storage Systems Group) and Lisa Gerhardt and Alberto Chiusole (Data and Analytics Services). We're still investigating the root cause, so a deeper analysis will be a topic for a future meeting. But we can discuss what we know so far, tips for working around impacts you experience as a result, and how we debug this kind of issue.
