

CHS HOMEWORK CLUB INFORMATION AND PERMISSION SLIP

Clifford Smart is offering an after school academic opportunity called **Homework Club**. Homework Club is open to select CHS students and will meet on **Thursdays** from **3:10-4:00 starting Thursday, November 9th**. Participating students will meet in room 100A near the office and spend time working on schoolwork and other academic endeavors. We are in the process of organizing peer tutors (other middle school students) to help club members. Tutors will be available when possible but are not guaranteed.

What Homework Club is:

- a quiet space to work
- a time to complete homework
- a time to study
- a time to read
- a time for individual work
- a time to study with one other student

What Homework Club isn't:

- it isn't a time to hang out with friends, talk, walk around the school, and/or loiter
- it isn't a time to sit around and play on electronic devices
- it isn't a time to form groups of more than two students

To make Homework Club a success we have a few requirements that students and parents need to be aware of.

Participating students should:

- have this permission slip signed and returned to **Mrs. Gray in the office**.
- report directly to Homework Club in room 100A by 3:10 and stay in the room until 4:00
- sign in as you enter Homework Club
- use the time to work on school materials / study
- be picked up at **4:00 in the main parking lot** (late pickups will result in removal from Homework Club)
- agree to **work quietly** by themselves, with a tutor, or study in groups of no more than 2 students

Homework Club will **start on Thursday, November 9th**. We will run on a trial basis and continue if we have enough interest. If a huge number of students return this form, we may have to limit the number of participants – so turn in your form ASAP.

Frequently Asked Questions

This sounds amazing – when does it start?

Our first Homework Club date is **Thursday, November 9th**. Please return this permission slip to Mrs. Gray in the office.

What times does it start and end?

3:10-4:00 every Thursday. Participating students report to Homework Club right after school. They will be released at 4:00 to meet their ride in the main parking lot. Parents should arrive at CHS a little before 4:00. Please wait in your car.

Does my student have to attend every Thursday?

No, you can attend as you see fit.

Is it ok if we only attend Homework Club a couple times?

Yes, absolutely!

Do we have to inform Mr. Abbott or the office if we cannot attend Homework Club on a given day?

No, if you aren't there, we will think fondly of you and look forward to seeing you in the future.

How many weeks will Homework Club run for? What are we committing to here?

Where do I pick my student up?

Please pick your student up at 4:00pm in the main parking lot at CHS.

What if I need to pick my student up early?

No problem! Just park in the main parking lot and meet us in room 100A. Come on in and let us know what's happening and we will let your student know it is time to leave.

What do I bring to Homework Club?

Please bring everything from your locker that you want to take home and anything you want to work on during Homework Club. After 3:10 students will not be allowed to return to their locker or go to other rooms in the school.

Can I bring my phone to Homework Club?

Yes, but you cannot use it from 3:10-4:00. Phones must be turned off and placed in your bag. We will treat cell phones just like we treat them in school. Students that break this rule will not be allowed to attend Homework Club in the future.

Can I bring my Nintendo Switch, Magic the Gathering Cards, or gaming system / toys?
