

**Project:** My Life "So Far" Slide Show Documentary

**Goal:** Create a slideshow that tells a compelling story of your identity using a 3-part structure.

You can't cover 15-16 years in 180 seconds. For this documentary activity we will pick **three** specific "chapters" or turning points that define who you are today. You will create a **slide show documentary** with a total of 16 slides.

1. **Chapter 1:** A childhood memory, a family tradition, or where you're from.
2. **Chapter 2:** A challenge you faced or a moment you changed your mind about something.
3. **Chapter 3:** Who are you at now? What is your "vibe" or goal(s) right now?

Plan your visuals. You need a mix of different images/collages to keep the audience engaged.

<b>Narrative Organization</b>	<b>Visual Ideas</b>
<b>Chapter 1/The Origin:</b> Introduce yourself. Where did it all start?	Childhood images (neighborhood pictures or images, your favorite childhood toy, etc)  *make sure to have an intentional opening line on slide #1  This will be slides 1 - 5 (each slide should have at least one image and sentence that connect with this section)
<b>Chapter 2/The Middle:</b> What shaped you? A challenge you faced or a moment you changed your mind about something.	This will be slides 6 - 10 (each slide should have at least one image and sentence that connect with this section)

<b>Chapter 3/The Now:</b> Where are you going? Who are you now? What is your "vibe" or goal(s) right now? A final thought.	This will be slides 11 - 15 (each slide should have at least one image and sentence that connect with this section)

**The Soundtrack:** Choose one song that fits the "mood" of your slideshow. Type the song, artist, and why you chose the selected song on slide #16.

### Grading Rubric

- **Narrative Flow:** Does the slide show have a clear beginning, middle, and end? (follow slide requirements)
- **Diction:** Do slides have appropriate language for each slide (opening line on slide one)
- **Imagery:** Do slides have appropriate images for each slide
