CISE uses **Harvard** referencing style. Citation more than one cited article/reference should be listed in order by year ([Belhekar et al. 2002](#); [Qian et al. 2014](#)).

2. Methods

Provide sufficient details and methods to allow the work to be reproduced. Methods already published should be indicated by a reference: only relevant modifications should be described.

2.1. Size of the Dataset

Formulae should be numbered consecutively throughout the manuscript as Equation 1, and Equation 2. In cases where the derivation of formulae has been abbreviated, it is of great help to the reviewers if the full derivation can be presented on a separate sheet (not to be published). All equations should be stated in text following the number.

Formulae should be mentioned in text, approximately in the center, and numbered on the align-right setting (see equation 1).

where L is the length of the river and C is the coefficient of runoff (see equation 2). Put a comma after the equation if it is not at the end of the sentence. If it is the end of the sentence, put a dot.

$$P_{Total,Gen} = \sum_{j=1}^m P_{Gen_j} \quad (2)$$

where P_{gen} is the generated precipitation.

2.1.1. ORF primary frames

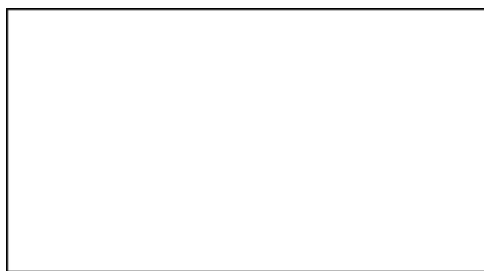


Figure 2 Storage performance result

In the case of photos, etc., a resolution of 300 dpi should be provided. Please make sure that all text in the Figures is readable - font size ≥ 8 pt. Figures and captions should be numbered and centered. Experimental results are presented in Figure 2.
