## 2025 AFW College Football Pick'em Rules and Regs

- 1) **Evan Kuchera** (evan.kuchera@gmail.com) is the 2025 commissioner. Please address all questions to me.
- 2) Pickem is completely online. Some information:
- a) You must enter your email (ID) correctly when submitting picks or they will not count
- b) The pick deadline is enforced by the webpage software--no exceptions will be allowed
- c) Once the pick deadline passes you will be able to see picks from other players
- d) You can re-submit picks as often as you like--your previous picks will be overwritten
- e) All submissions are emailed to <u>afwafootball@gmail.com</u> automatically as a backup
- 3) Weekly picks will consist of 10 games against the spread, with four games chosen by me or my designee, and six additional unique games picked by you using the games provided.
- 4) To participate in this pool, you must register before the third week's deadline and play every week. You may miss two weeks (out of the total) of the regular season and still be eligible for the final season standings. All postseason games (weeks 15-17) will be mandatory.
- 5) Picks will typically be due at 6:00 PM CT Thursday night each week. Each week's new picks will generally be available on Sunday evening or Monday. Bowls/playoffs will be split into two groupings, with the first due 13 December and the second due 27 December. We will not play the national semifinal or final games.
- 6) Order of standings will be determined by winning percentage. Games that end in a push (i.e. the final score margin equals the spread) will not be counted in the standings.
- 7) Tiebreakers–if players are tied in the standings after a week is played, the one who had their final pick submission entered earliest will be considered to be higher in the standings at the end of that week.
