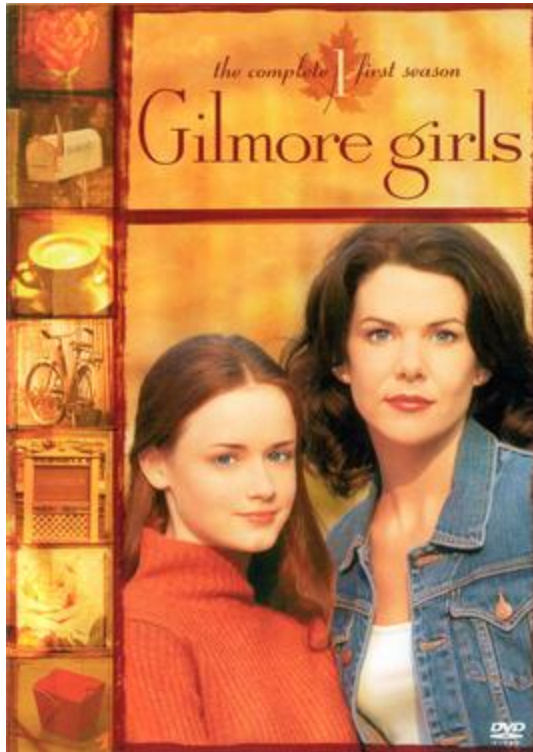




Gilmore Girls
