### Where are we from

#### Can-Do Statement:

##### Part 1: Prepare

Prepare the questions and responses you would need to have a conversation introducing yourself to your classmates. Fill out the following (use as many Arabic letters as you can) and make note of the dialect you are using:

التَّحِيَّةُ : at-taHiyya (greeting)

السُّؤَالُ عَنْ الْإِسْمِ : as-su'aal °an al-ism

الْإِسْمُ : al-ism

السُّؤَالُ عَنْ الْحَالِ : as-su'aal °an al-Haal

حَالُكَ : Haalak

السُّؤَالُ "مِنْ أَيْنَ" : as-su'aal min ayna

مِنْ أَيْنَ أَنْتَ : min ayna ant

مَدِينَةٌ : madina

وِلَايَةٌ / دَوْلَةٌ : wilaya / dawla (country)

الْمُجَامَلَاتُ : al-mujaamilaat (pleasantries such as 'nice to meet you')
