2) Create a CFNC account (USE YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL)

- 3) <u>Create a Common App Account!</u> The Common App is a central, online application for students to apply to over 1000+ colleges and universities around the world! It is where you'll find the <u>Common App Essay prompts</u>, add your recommenders (<u>send them your brag sheet as well</u>), and research which colleges you want to apply to. You can find a guide on <u>how to use Common App here!</u>
- 4) Complete the RDS (Residency Determination Service) (sign in using your CFNC account) The RDS determines if you qualify for in-state or out-of-state tuition for NC schools and is open continuously! (RDS is confidential so any information you put into it will not be shared with immigration authorities) It is used in order to help you pay for school as an IN-STATE RESIDENT as out-of-state tuition is 3 TIMES MORE THAN IN STATE.

- 5) Create an FSA ID (FAFSA Account) and have your parent(s) create one too! (If your parent(s) DO NOT have a Social Security Number (SSN), that is okay! They can still create an account!) Here is a free, online, downloadable guide in multiple languages explaining FAFSA! The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is to apply for Federal Student AID and opens on October 1st. BE SURE TO CREATE A FSA ID AND HAVE YOUR PARENT(S)/GUARDIAN(S) CREATE ONE.
- 6) Fill out the CSS Profile (only if necessary)

If you are looking to apply to **UNC Chapel Hill, Duke, Elon, Wake Forest, or Davidson** in North Carolina, you are **REQUIRED** to submit the CSS Profile in your first-year application. The CSS Profile is a non federal financial aid application that can help students unlock financial aid from private sources. It opens on **October 1st**. You and 1 parent need an account to fill it out along with **paying an initial fee of \$25 and \$16 for any additional school** you want to add. **Get started here with the CSS Profile**

- 7) Look into Scholarships! You can also start your scholarship search now. Look into the CFNC Scholarships. Scholarship applications also depend on the university! Check out the Jordan Student Services website on the scholarship page. If your household income is below \$80,000 a year then you may qualify for the NC NEXT Scholarship. It pays for more than half, if not all, of tuition and fees at any of the 16 public universities in the state! You can also look at more scholarships on my Scholarship Slide and bookmark ones you want to apply to!
- 8) Check out released essays to get a preview of what colleges may be looking for! Use this as a base and if you need me to look over your essays, please share them with me! Work with your English IV teacher to go over your essay (if you had English IV last year or have it next semester, reach out to that teacher now) I would create a base essay based on the Common App prompts so you can send that to multiple colleges! 14 released college essays: https://www.shemmassianconsulting.com/blog/college-essay-examples
