- New Word document version [here](#). This is where comments should go.
- Four current focus areas (Equity, Operational Excellence, Environmental Sustainability, Technological Innovation)
 - Can we create some topical sub-bullets to be clearer about the topics that this committee is most interested in
 - That could help to guide TRB in directing papers towards our committee (as opposed to other transit-related committees)
- We created our first Communications Plan. Will need to cleanup the language in the Strategic Plan around Communications
 - Level of detail we want to include in our communications
 - What do we have capacity to maintain (e.g. website)
 - Monthly online meetings instead of quarterly
 - How do we connect with Friends of the Committee and also reach out to those who are not currently engaged with TRB process/committees
- Q: Do we want to include more on the needs of operators (e.g., drivers) (as opposed to external focus on customers). Is that in the scope of the committee?
 - Yes: Adding this as a line under to Operational Excellence makes sense.

- o This relates to the “Management” focus of the committee
- One goal of this work is to address overlap with the scope of other committees so we can clarify and collaborate.
 - o Claire: to get more to the “management” side of our work, potentially coordinate with these others committees:
 - AJE10 - Strategic Management
 - AJE15 - Workforce development and Organization Development

0. TRB putting hold on change to paper submittal for 2025 Conference.

- Process for paper submissions will stay the same for now
- One minor change: There will be a requirement for accepted papers to provide an extended summary that will appear online
- Conversation continues
- There is no current process for soliciting/providing input.
- Want to make sure this information gets out the research community since they are working on summer plans .

- TRB will also reach out later this summer to get more feedback

 - o Workshop Title: **Navigating the Rising TIDES – Exploring the Present and Future of Transit Data Standards**
 - o Sponsor and co-sponsor committees:
 - AP090 - Sponsor
 - AED20 - Urban Data - proposed
 - AP010 - Transit Performance - proposed
 - o Blurb: TIDES (Transit ITS Data Exchange Specification) is an emerging standard for accessing, managing, and using data generated by transit technology systems, currently managed by MobilityData (the GTFS governing body). This workshop will demonstrate current implementations of TIDES, crowdsource solutions to implementation challenges including NTD reporting and performance dashboards, and collaboratively explore opportunities to extend TIDES to new data and new use cases for industry and research.
