

The Leadership class for LAW is currently being taught by Dr. Terra Wright. She is our Curriculum Effectiveness Specialist (CES). She has experience teaching the Leadership class, so your students are definitely in good, capable hands. In the meantime, our principal, Ms. Taylor, is working on solidifying the Law Lead Teacher position so all information will come directly from her.

How do parents get on to Google Classroom?

Each advisory teacher will send a form to collect parents' emails to invite them.
