

2024 NH GOP Bylaws Proposals

Amendment 3

Sponsor: Rep. JR Hoell, Merrimack.

Brief Description: **Establishing Observer and Voting Members of the Executive Committee; changing the voting status of some members.**

AMENDMENT:

In ARTICLE IV, replace the first and second sentences of this article with the following:

The Executive Committee shall consist of the following voting members: Chairman, the Vice Chairman; the National Committeeman; the National Committeewoman; the Finance Chairman; the Treasurer; the Assistant Treasurer; the Secretary; the Assistant Secretary; the Assistant to the Chair for Recruitment; the five Regional Vice Chairmen; the ten County Chairmen; the City Chairmen who qualify under Article VI; representatives, designated in writing, of each Republican member of the United States Senate and the House of Representatives; of the Republican Leader of the New Hampshire State Senate, selected by a majority vote of the Republican Caucus; of the Republican Leader of the New Hampshire House of Representatives, selected by a majority vote of the Republican Caucus; of the Republican Governor and one Republican member of the Executive Council (chosen among themselves), and the following non-voting advisory members: the President of the New Hampshire Federation of Republican Women; the President of the New Hampshire Young Republican Federation; the Chairman of the New Hampshire College Republicans. Voting members of the Executive Committee may designate a surrogate, in writing, to attend the Executive Committee meetings on their behalf and to vote in their stead.

Executive Committee Vote: Majority did not recommend.
