Room 10 discovered a boulder!

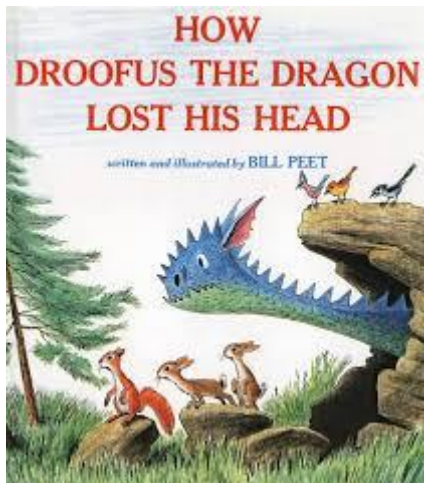
