

Unique Collections Team Goals

- Identify questions and areas of common interest for unique collections in relation to Alma and Primo, the opportunities the NZ affords to engage with these, and collaborations with other teams needed to move forward.
- Identify a chair during their initial meeting, and establish meeting times and frequencies, and communication channels, including scheduling ad-hoc meetings to provide support to member libraries.
- Review [Network zone-related policy decisions](#), identify those impacting unique collections, and determine a timeline and process for engaging with other teams in resolving them.
- The Unique Collections Team will identify liaisons from within the team to the Access Services, Cataloging, and Discovery teams. These liaisons or their designates will stay abreast of the other teams' discussion and agendas, optionally join their meetings to participate in discussions, and serve as a conduit for Unique Collections' concerns to these teams, and for the teams' discussions to the Unique Collections Team.
