Singular Noun (1)	Rules:	Plural Nouns (2, 3, 4...)
1. Most nouns: a sister, a bedroom a key, a niece	<i>Add -s</i>	sisters bedrooms keys nieces
2. Nouns that end in -sh, -s, -ch, -x : a watch a box, a class	<i>Add -es</i>	watches boxes classes
3. Nouns that end with a consonant -y : a baby a city, a family	<i>Drop the -y & add -ies</i>	babies cities families
4. Nouns that end in -f or -fe : a knife, a leaf	<i>Drop the -f or -fe & add -ves</i>	knives leaves
5. Irregular nouns: a child, a person a woman, a man a mouse a fish a foot, a tooth	No -s	children people women men mice fish feet teeth
