Important: Please enter "The Crystal Maze Manchester" into Google Maps rather than using our postcode, as local construction may cause confusion.

Reform Radio is located within the Bonded Warehouse, next door to the Museum of Science & Industry (MOSI) and the Crystal Maze Live Experience.

If you are looking at the main entrance of the MOSI main entrance, walk down the first small road on the right of the museum cafe. You will see small bollards in front of you and signs for the Crystal Maze. Walk through the bollards and all the way to the end of the street. The entrance to Bonded Warehouse reception is on your right, over the way from the Crystal Maze. Press the buzzer located on the right hand side of the double doors.

If you have any access needs in order to enter the building, please let your contact know in advance or email shout@reformradio.co.uk to organise access.

Note: The following instructions are to reach the main entrance which is open before 6PM. For those arriving after 6PM please call the office on either 0161 806 0879 to reach a member of staff who can come to the front entrance and let you in.

Parking

NOTE: There is no parking at Bonded Warehouse.

Accessible Parking can sometimes be requested in advance, so let us know if you have any accessibility needs.

Duke Street Car Park

The best car park to access is the Castleville Estates Duke Street Car Park in Castlefield, M3 4AZ. Here are the GPS coordinates and directions, it's just under the arch.

It's £7 all day.

Bridgewater Street

Another Car Park is Euro Car Park on Bridgewater Street, M3 4LY and costs £7.00 for all day parking. From there, walk onto Deansgate and turn left and then take the next left turn onto Liverpool Road. Head straight on until you reach the museum on your right over the road, then cross at the zebra crossing. Just after passing the Museum of Science and Industry main entrance, on your left, take the small road on your left. At the end enter the building on your right.

Parking outside the Science & Industry Museum

There are pay & display parking spots outside the museum located on Lower Byrom Street. If you use these please ensure you pay & display appropriately. These are for short periods only.

Accessible Parking

You can park at the pay & display parking bays outside the museum free of charge, <u>as long</u> as you display a blue badge.

Public Transport

Trains

Piccadilly Train Station

Take the 1 Free Bus that runs from outside Piccadilly Station to Quay Street (8 Stops), then walk downhill until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

OR

Take the 2 Free bus that runs from outside Piccadilly Station to Deansgate (5 Stops). Walk back down the direction you just came on the bus and turn right onto Liverpool Road. Head straight on until you reach the museum on your right over the road, then cross at the zebra crossing. Just after passing the Museum of Science and Industry main entrance take the small road on your left. At the end enter the building on your right.

OR

Walk downhill from the station to Piccadilly Gardens and head to the entrance of Primark. From the entrance, turn left and head straight on until you pass Manchester Central Library. Turn right and walk until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

Deansgate Train Station

Leave the station and cross the road onto Whitworth Street West, cross over the street, turn left and follow the pavement to the right and underneath the bridge. When you reach the Hilton, cross the road and turn left onto Liverpool Road. Head straight on until you reach the museum on your right over the road, then cross at the zebra crossing. Just after passing the Museum of Science and Industry main entrance take the small road on your left. At the end enter the building on your right.

Manchester Oxford Road Train Station

Leave the station and turn left, cross over the road at Sainsburys to get onto Oxford Street. Walk along Oxford Street until you reach Manchester Central Library and cross over the road. Continue to follow the road until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

Manchester Victoria Train Station

Leave Manchester Victoria station, cross the road and turn right. Cross the gardens outside the National Football Museum and head down Cathedral Street (between Manchester Cathedral and the Corn Exchange). Head up the stairs and continue down New Cathedral Street until you reach a crossroads. Cross over the street and there will be a bus stop on your right. Take the 1 Free Bus that runs from there to Hardman Street (3 Stops), then head left. At the road, turn right and walk downhill until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the

next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

OR

Leave Manchester Victoria station, cross the road and turn right. Cross the gardens outside the National Football Museum turn right to pass Manchester Cathedral, turn left when the path splits and left again to come onto Deansgate. Follow the road until you reach the crossroads where Sainsburys is across the road from you and turn right. Walk downhill until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

Salford Central Station

Leave the station, turn right onto the A34 towards Albert Bridge. Over the bridge take the second right onto Gartside Street. At the end of the street turn right onto Quay Street. Take the second right onto Lower Byrom Street. After you pass the park to the left, there will be a sign for Bonded Warehouse. Turn right down there and the Crystal Maze building is on the left and Reform is in the wooden doors just after on the right.

Salford Crescent Station

Leave the station and turn left onto the A6 and walk until you reach the Ring Road. Turn right onto the Ring Road and follow until you reach the 6th right onto Lower Byrom Street. After you pass the park to the left, there will be a sign for Bonded Warehouse. Turn right down there and the Crystal Maze building is on the left and Reform is in the wooden doors just after on the right.

OR

Take the train to Deansgate then follow the instructions above.

OR

Walk to Salford Crescent Station Stop A and take either the 36, 37, 38, 50, or V1 Vantage bus and get off at the 5th Stop on Bridge Street. Get off the bus and turn right and walk til you reach Deansgate. Go right down Deansgate and after the Federal Cafe, turn right onto Quay Street. Walk til you see the ABC Building and turn left onto Lower Byrom Street. After you pass the park to the left, there will be a sign for Bonded Warehouse. Turn right down there and the Crystal Maze building is on the left and Reform is in the wooden doors just after on the right.

Metrolink

St Peter's Square Tram Stop

Head towards Manchester Central Library and turn left and walk until you've walked past it. Turn right from there and walk until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

Deansgate Castlefield Tram Stop

Leave the station and turn right, follow the road and turn right again and pass under the bridge. When you reach the Hilton, cross the road and turn left onto Liverpool Road. Head straight on until you reach the museum on your right over the road, then cross at the zebra crossing. Just after passing the Museum of Science and Industry main entrance take the small road on your left. At the end enter the building on your right.

Major Bus Stops

Piccadilly Gardens

Head to the entrance of Primark. Turn left and head straight on until you pass Manchester Central Library. Turn right from there and walk until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

Shudehill Interchange

Walk into the Arndale, leave an exit on the opposite side and turn right. Walk down the hill until you reach LUSH on your left and there should be a bus stop in front of you. Take the 1 Free Bus that runs from there to Hardman Street (3 Stops), then head left. At the road, turn right and walk downhill until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

OR

Leave Shudehill Interchange onto the main road, then turn left. At the car park turn left and walk down the road until you reach Long Millgate Car Park. Turn left and then follow the pathway along, passing through the grass outside the National Football Museum. Turn right to pass Manchester Cathedral, turn left when the path splits and left again to come onto Deansgate. Follow the road until you reach the crossroads where Sainsburys is across the

road from you and turn right. Walk downhill until you pass M&S, cross the road and take the next left. From there continue straight on until just before the Museum of Science and Industry and take the small road on your right. At the end enter the building on your right.

Uber/Taxis

If heading to Reform in a taxi or uber, use Bonded Warehouse as the address. You can then walk from Lower Byrom Street or use the buzzer to speak to security who will take the bollards down and allow your driver to drive straight to the main entrance. Or alternatively, get dropped outside the MOSI and walk down which can be easier if no access needs.

Cycling

If you would like to cycle to Reform, there are bike racks outside the Bonded Warehouse building, between Bonded and the Crystal Maze. **Do not lock your bike on the CRYSTAL MAZE railings.** There is also a bike store on floor 2 inside Bonded. Please let us know if you require this.

BeeBike

There are BeeBike racks at both ends of Lower Byrom Street, a 2 minute walk from Bonded Warehouse, more information and locations can be found on the Beryl App.
