



Heroes Helping 2025 Scholarship Application

The Atchison Police Department's Heroes Helping program was started in 2020 by Officer Alex Moore in an effort to provide school supplies and shoes to children who might otherwise go without. Heroes Helping has funded this program through the annual "Heroes Helping Golf Tournament" along with private donations from community members and local businesses.

Heroes Helping is offering a scholarship opportunity for eligible students at the following schools: Atchison High School, Maur Hill-Mount Academy, and Atchison County Community High School. The scholarship provides financial assistance to scholarship winners for their continued education. **For 2025, Heroes Helping will offer a total of six scholarships. Two \$500 scholarships to selected students at each of the three local schools.** All applicants must meet the requirements and criteria listed below.

All applicants must meet the following requirements:

1. Enrolled as a student in a high school in Atchison County, Kansas.
2. Graduation from one of the three local High Schools in the 2025 school year
3. Continuing your education at a vocational school or a 2-4 year college.
4. Must complete a 250-500 word essay. Explained on page 4 of the application.
5. Obtain a recommendation from a community member.

Criteria for judging applications:

1. Quality of Essay
2. Participation in extracurricular activities or community service.
3. Recommendation from a community member. (Use form provided.)

To apply, complete the attached scholarship application. Please type or print clearly. All applications must be submitted to Heroes Helping at 515 Kansas Avenue, Atchison, KS 66002, and postmarked no later than April 15, 2025.

Verification of enrollment from a vocational-technical school, 2- or 4-year college of your choice will be needed in order to release any scholarship funds awarded. If a scholarship winner

chooses not to continue his or her education after high school, the scholarship award will not be awarded to that individual. Recipients have 12 months from the awarding of the scholarship to access the money. Unclaimed funds will be made available to future scholarship applicants.
