3. Support from relevant theories and recent studies (within the last 5 years).
4. The research purpose, which is clearly stated in the final paragraph.

The methods should be written clearly and concisely, with enough detail to allow for replication.

The important point of conclusion is **Fundamental Finding --> Implication --> Future Research.**

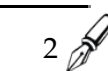
