

FOREIGN STUDENT PROGRAM
ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

The Mt. Mansfield Unified Union School District supports activities designed to improve student knowledge of foreign cultures and to contribute to international understanding through personal school and community experiences. These activities should improve the foreign student's knowledge of our culture and language through active participation in family, school and community life.

Administrative Procedures

The Board will approve tuition waivers for foreign exchange students as long as the following criteria are met.

1. Any student not permanently residing in the United States will be considered as a foreign exchange student.
2. Tuition may be waived for a number of students not to exceed 1% of the previous years' student enrollment.
3. Tuition for a foreign exchange student may be waived for those students enrolled with an approved International Educational Travel and Exchange Program, provided that a program coordinator for the student resides within a 25-mile radius of the school.
4. Request for exchange placements from a Board approved program should be received by the principal and/or guidance coordinator by March 1st for the following September.
5. It is recommended as a courtesy to the school that the name of the potential host family and the student's portfolio be submitted to the principal and/or guidance coordinator prior to any commitment to either of the above listed parties.
