GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR EDUCATION WEEK 2026

1. Team Composition, Eligibility, and Participation

- The Institute of Teacher Education is composed of **four (4) academic programs**, which shall serve as the official competing teams during the Education Week celebration.
- All events are open to bona fide Education students from all year levels under their respective programs.
- **Each program is required to field at least one (1) team or one (1) representative in every event**, unless otherwise specified in the event mechanics.
- Participants must compete **under their enrolled program**, and cross-program representation is strictly prohibited.
- Programs are encouraged to maximize participation to promote unity, collaboration, and healthy competition.

2. Registration and Deadlines

- All teams and individual participants must accomplish the official registration form on or before the announced deadline.
- All information submitted during registration must be accurate and complete. Any false or misleading information may result in disqualification.
- Registration forms may be obtained from the Education Society Office or from authorized committee members.

3. Attendance and Punctuality

- Participants are required to be present at the venue at least fifteen (15) before the scheduled start of their event.
- Failure to arrive on time may result in disqualification or loss of points depending on the event rules.

4. Event-Specific Rules

- Each event will have an additional set of **specific mechanics** and guidelines. Participants are responsible for reading and understanding these before joining.
- Failure to follow event-specific rules may lead to point deductions or disqualification.

5. Amendments to Guidelines

- Each activity has an accompanying set of mechanics and criteria that must be strictly observed.
- Participants are expected to read and fully understand the event-specific guidelines prior to participation.
- Non-compliance with any rule may lead to penalties, point deductions, or disqualification.

6. General Point Allocation

- Points shall be awarded to each program based on their final ranking in every official event. These points will be accumulated across all academic, socio-cultural, and Laro ng Lahi events to determine the Overall Champion of Education Week 2026.



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PLACEMENT	POINTS EARNED
Champion	10 points
1 st Runner-up	7 points
2 nd Runner-up	5 points

7. Point Deduction

- To ensure fairness, discipline, and proper conduct, point deductions shall be imposed on programs for violations of rules and guidelines. Deductions shall be applied to the total accumulated points of the program concerned.

VIOLATION	POINT DEDUCTION
Late arrival (with allowed participation)	1 point
Minor rule violation (e.g., dress code, minor procedural lapses)	1 to 2 points
Unsportsmanlike conduct (profanity, disrespect to officials)	3 points
Major rule violation (use of ineligible participant, aggravated breach)	5 points
Failure to field a team/representative in a required event	5 points
Disqualification from an event due to rule violation	5 points
Repeated or intentional violations	Additional penalties at committee's discretion

8. Amendments to Guidelines

- The Education Week Committee reserves the right to modify or clarify rules when necessary. Participants will be informed of any changes in a timely manner.
