

## New Combat Medical System

In order to get Combat Medic in all battalions (Judicials, 212th, 501st, 41st, and ARF) they join a 349th Class for a trainee phase in which they will learn how to do basic stabilization rp, alongside how to operate the 349th Equipment if need be, once they have learned their training they are free to join any battalion's Combat Medic program and will keep the rank of the had prior to joining the Trainee program.

They will learn how to cauterize stab and projectile wounds.

They will learn how to use tourniquets both premade and makeshift.

They will learn how to treat 1st and 2nd degree.

In return for a new CM School system, CMs can get advanced gear again, this means only the advanced medkit and defibs, any Staff or EMs seen giving out other Medical Equipment will be reported to their heads, any members of CM seen using the gear will be blacklisted and stripped of their ability to receive advanced gear. This blacklisting will be public and any person trying to avoid the Blacklisting will be reported to staff.

(This means you cannot give out the stim-unit, medical propulsion station, armor kit, bacta grenade; to any CMs)

Combat Medic Maxes will be adjusted when they reach max, not before. The CO of the Battalion of the Maxed CMs will talk to the 349th CO and give reasons why their Max CM should be increased. The Max only stays for that singular CM, once they leave or get demoted for bad behavior or inactivity, the max will be returned to the previous level that it was prior to the adding of another slot. This means if the CM Max was at 4 and the person left, the Max would return to 3 and not stick to 4, meaning you would have to go back to negotiate another CM if you desired to get one.

Honorary Members: Veteran or Honorary or Reserve Members of a battalion STILL COUNT as part of the CM Max, if you want to remove their CM (They will keep their training) they will be removed and unmarked as a CM. To return as a CM you would need to talk to the 349th CO to make sure they know that they will be re-added to the Max.

Getting Advanced Gear: In order to retrieve advanced gear (aka the advanced medkit and defibs) You must ask the highest ranking Medic(349th) On, if they say no, then you will not retrieve medkits and defibs, if they say yes then you are free to give out advanced gear to CMs only. Medically Trained Personnel can only retrieve the STIM-Unit if CMs are on, if there are no CMs and no Medics, CO/XOs and NCOs who have Medical Training can receive the advanced gear. If there are no 349th on, you may give out gear as if a 349th said yes, however if a 349th gets on you are to ask them if you can continue handing out gear. Anyone found not following these rules will be blacklisted and reported for handing out gear without authority to.
