Swimming Pool

The swimming pool is now almost ready for school use following some extensive remedial work undertaken last week. Students will be able to start using the pool on Monday. It is important that our tamariki wear togs or other proper swimwear in the pool as ordinary cotton clothing (Tee shirts etc) sucks up the chlorine quickly and makes it difficult to keep the water in good condition.

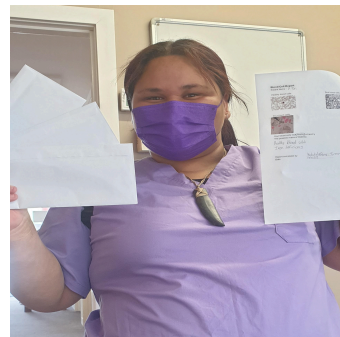
Parent/Teacher Catch ups this Week

COVID Protection Framework - Operating in RED

- Year 5 - 13 students and their teachers are expected to wear face coverings whilst indoors.
- Face coverings are not required to be worn by staff or students, for Years 1 – 4.
- For all ākonga aged 12 and upwards, face coverings are mandatory on school transport, and when accessing public venues.
- Assemblies and gatherings will be held outdoors
- Regular hand washing throughout the day is important
- **1m** physical distancing should be applied where practicable.
- No non-essential visitors on site.
- All visitors, including parents and caregivers, if they do come onsite should wear face coverings
