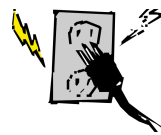

Here's what you need to know for this year's Science Fair!

- Projects may include experiments, observations, collections, inventions, models, engineering, or research!
- Students must work individually or with **one** partner (per the Greater St. Louis Science Fair guidelines).

Safety Plan

- Mr. Kearney will email your signed safety form (worth 10 pts) after receiving your safety plan on the registration form. Safety plans must include the following:
 - Who will be supervising your project?
 - What is the question or problem being addressed?
 - Describe the method or procedure you will use to address the question or problem.
 - What safety considerations need to be in place? (ie - wear safety goggles, keep chemicals away from younger siblings, etc.)

Required Format

Students may present their findings on a trifold display board with a logbook or digitally (submit slidedeck and logbook as a PDF to brendankearney@claytonschoools.net). **Please note that all projects selected to represent Glenridge at the Greater St. Louis Science Fair (GSLSF) must be submitted digitally per GSLSF rules.** My recommendation is to build the project as a digital slideshow and print the slides for a trifold board if your child wants a physical display.
