To complete the [Masters degree](#) - Masters of Science in Education (MSEd.) there are two additional courses EDU 600 Research Methods and EDU 643 Inquiry in Education that are designed to be taken 3-5 years after completion of your teacher certification program listed above. The goal is to be an established teacher and return to the university to learn to conduct research on your own teaching practices to continue to be a career long learner and improve your practice. Your school district contract will then pay for the courses.
