Call sheets or “daily call sheets” are documents based on your daily shot lists. It’s a schedule that is distributed to the cast and crew letting them know where they need to be on set. Call sheets are necessary for each day of filming.

Not all productions need as detailed a call sheet as the one used in the video -- if I would've busted one of these babies out during a production meeting with my college buddies, they would've said I was trying too hard and left me to pay the bar tab. **Call sheets** are meant to inform your team of all pertinent information for a day of shooting, so you'll probably want to make sure to include (at least) the following stuff on yours:

- Call times
- Locations
- Parking information
- Where base camp is
- What scenes are being shot
- Which actors are in which scenes
- Lunch time
- Directions to nearest hospital
- Weather info
- Contact info
- Next day's schedule
