INT. APARTMENT - MORNING

INT. OFFICE

MAN is typing at a keyboard. He types something with his fish hands, then presses backspace. This repeats a few times. Cut to a shot of his screen, showing a document with a bunch of nonsense typed into it. Back to MAN. He tries to move the mouse around and knocks it off his desk.

## INT. LUNCH ROOM - DAY

MAN sits at a table in front of a sandwich. He sits for a few moments, eyeing the sandwich. Finally, he tries to pick it up between his fish hands and drops it all over his lap.

## INT. BATHROOM

Music stops. MAN is standing in front of a toilet. We hear the sound of him peeing while seeing him from behind. He finishes peeing and goes to the sink. His fish hands briefly struggle to turn it on, but he succeeds. MAN still looks mildly frustrated. MAN places his fish hands under the water. His face melts into a relieved expression, like he just took a great piss.
