

# Activate/deactivate a course and Adjust OPEN Date



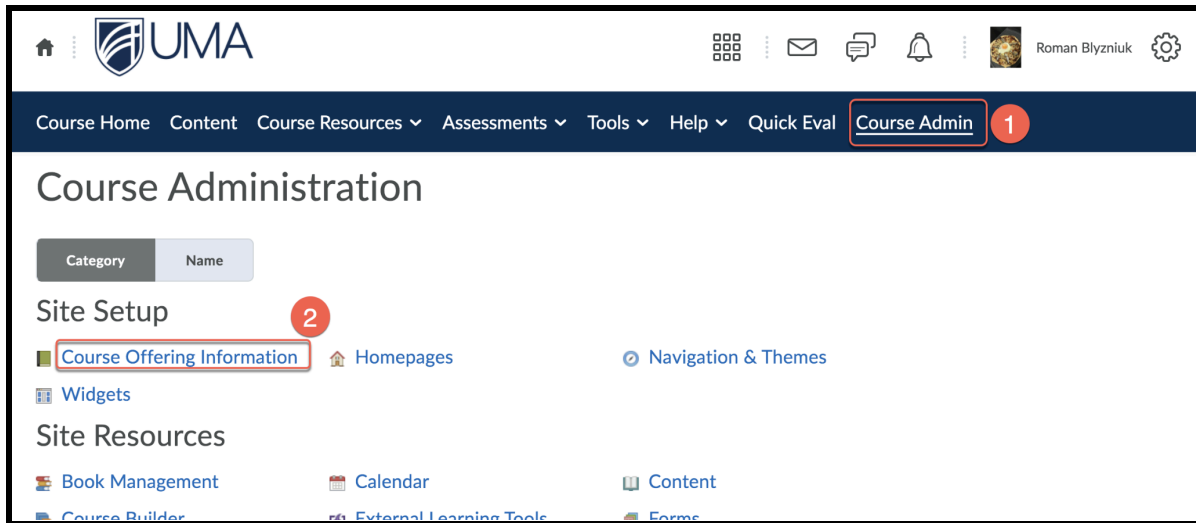

Classes in Brightspace will become accessible to students one week before the semester or course Open Date, whichever is first. This is determined by the date courses begin in Mainstreet.

Making courses **Active** with a **Course Open Date** benefits students by making the course tile visible to them in their **My Courses** widget. This provides students with clear confirmation that they are successfully enrolled in the course. Even though they can see the course tile, they can not access the course until the **Course Open Date** set in the **Course Offering Information** area.

Courses that are active and accessible need to have, at the least, a syllabus and welcome message. All other content not ready for student view can be hidden.

2. Click on **Course Admin** in the **Navigation bar**.
3. Click on **Course Offering Information**.



It will take you to the Course Offering Information page. Scroll down till you see **Course is Active** checkbox:

4. Check the **Course is Active** box.
5. Set a **Course Opens** and **Course Closes** dates.
6. Click **Save**

- The course will be visible for the students but they will not be able to access it until the date that you set as the **Course Opens** date. This will also negate the risk of accidentally forgetting to switch the course back to active.
- Students will see the course on their homepages and the **Course Opens** date will appear on the course banner. They will, however, not be able to access the course until the **Course Opens** date and time have passed. They can pin it to the top of the list for easy access.
