## Parent Contract 2025/26 School Year

As parents at Stride Christian Academy:

- 1. We long for our travelers to discover a calling that will change the world, as promised in Stride Christian Academy's mission; please see <a href="Acton Academy's mission">Acton Academy's mission</a> for levels of control, which we follow and adhere to. We will allow our traveler to fail early, cheaply and as often as necessary without intervening, and in the event our traveler struggles, we will refer to the <a href="Hero's Journey for Parents note">Hero's Journey for Parents note</a> for counsel before reacting.
- We welcome Stride Christian Academy as a self-paced environment where travelers run the studios through the delegation of certain rights by owners and parents, with access to <u>dozens of experts for instruction</u>, allowing Mentors to focus on challenges and questions.
- 3. We will celebrate our traveler's progress in earning Weekly Points, Badges, and Positive 360 Peer Coaching Reviews according to a learning plan we create, and act if needed to: remove distractions like gaming, video, or social media; lessen resistance or overcome feelings of victimhood so our traveler can soar.
- 4. Further, for our own Hero's Journeys as parents
  - We will remain lifelong learners and each will have an active learning project (such as a book or self-improvement project) at all times to discuss with our children.
  - At least one of us will attend at least two of the three Parent Meetings each year, where Socratic discussions will focus on our Hero's Journey as parents.
  - We will deliver our travelers to campus before 8:30 am and understand travelers who arrive late may not participate in that morning's activities.
