

As we continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation, we are aware that many of you are facing all kinds of unexpected challenges, from school closures, to work shutdowns, and beyond. This is certainly an unprecedented time and it requires wisdom, discernment, and ingenuity. **We have closed camp for the months of March and April, but at this point, we are choosing to remain open in the month of May, which means trips are projected to proceed as usual.** However, given that the situation is still very fluid, we want you to be aware that that decision is subject to change. **We will make the official call (and let you know via email or phone call) by April 10th.** Given that there are still many unknowns, we want to offer our guests as much flexibility as we can. Along that vein, we have several options for you, in terms of how your group may want to proceed moving forward:

1. **Option #1: Reschedule your trip for Summer 2020**--Trips choosing this option will be at our other campsite (The Cove), which is still a riverfront property, so you won't experience any change in trip quality; just know that camp will look different than the one you're used to if you've visited with us before. Depending on how things develop with the containment of the Coronavirus, this is also subject to change, but we are prayerfully optimistic that things will have improved enough to still run our summer program as usual.
2. **Option #2: Roll your trip over to Spring 2021**--Help out Rock-N-Water by electing to roll your 2020 deposit over to a 2021 trip. Schools that choose to do this will be given priority; we just need your 1st and 2nd choice 2021 trip dates by April 15th. Your deposit will already be accounted for, and you'll have the peace of mind that all the initial logistics are handled, plus your trip will already be on the calendar. This option also helps us to mitigate the costs of closing for March and April. This may be the best option for schools forced to cancel their trips on account of closures.
3. **Option #3: We can refund your deposit**--Times are uncertain--we get it. If you don't feel that you are in a place to confidently commit to a 2021 trip and find yourselves either unwilling or unable to attend this year, we apologize. Obviously, none of us could have seen this coming. In good faith, we are going to suspend our normal policy of withholding non-refundable deposits as an exception for your trips.

Whatever your decision, know that we understand. We are praying God's comfort and peace for all of you, and hoping that this whole situation teaches us how to lean into the Lord more and trust Him for wisdom, protection, and guidance.
