Specific Settings

Occupational therapy may be present within the following facilities:

- Inpatient psychiatric facilities adult or pediatric
- Community based programs
- Clubhouses
- Substance use treatment facilities
- Residential facilities
- Correctional facilities
- Homeless shelters

Dress code

Dress codes are typically site specific, but generally the following parameters are accepted in most settings:

- Clothing
 - Business casual
 - Scrub top and scrub pants
 - Scrub pants with a plain shirt **OR** a shirt that represents the specific organization and/or occupational therapy
- Shoes
 - Clean, closed toed, and correctly sized
 - Must be appropriate to the work performed
- Accessories
 - Limit jewelry (bracelets, earrings, rings necklaces) and scarves as they may pose a safety risk to yourself and others
- ID badges
 - Must be worn, viewable, and accessible at all times (however, this is site specific)
