THE CABINET:

THE POLICY:

There is not much time until the election, certainly not enough for a full programme at least. Until then we must take any action we can, here are some policies we will be focusing on:

FM's Office:

- Attempt to get treaties (UN, CoE and the like) into law in order to advance human rights protections and cement our place as a sanctuary for all in the world.
- Commission an audit into our feasibility of meeting the copenhagen criteria, to see what measures we can take as a nation to get closer to the EU.

Counsel General's Office:

- Ensure the government follows the rule of law with every single action.
- Audit of the previous government's health nationalisation plans, and seeing whether they were feasible or legal.

Finance:

- Passing a budget that delivers for Wales, building on the Clean Slate previously passed.
- Raising LVT slightly to reduce pressures on our reserves.
- Freezing interest on all student debt and purchasing sold out debt from private collection companies to reduce the burden on already struggling students.
- Attending the devolved assemblies conference for deprivation grant restoration, to restore the balance for Wales.

Justice:

- Implementing the Merseyside model to protect sex workers.
- Welsh office of abuse prevention to be established, protecting our population and implementing safeguards.
- Implementing Lords Committee on Institutional Abuse findings into law.

Health:

- Expansion of Telemedicine, easing pressure on our NHS and easing pressure on patients less able to travel to their GP.
- Free Dental Care. Mouth health is also a human right!

Local Gov:

- Full parishing of local government to ensure uniformity on how governance is done in Wales.
- Implementation of the European charter of local self government into Welsh common law, a fundamental step in the right direction for human rights in Wales.

Infrastructure:

- Intermodal Freight Terminal for Port Talbot, allowing for an economic boost for the local area and giving the country a valuable goods transportation resource.
- Metros for South and North Wales, to ensure that people in both lands can get around quicker and to stimulate our economy.
- Make use of newly acquired crown estate lands for energy generation, ensuring our energy independence for decades to come.

Culture:

- Investment into a 360 stage for Film Cymru Wales to encourage production to come to Wales.
- Feasibility study on replacing tax breaks with subsidies for the protection of modern theatre act.

Agriculture and Rural Affairs:

- Price floors will be implemented on certain farmed goods to ensure that farmers cannot be unreasonably exploited for their produce.
- Police will be made to record livestock attacks to ensure farmers have more security.

Education:

- Scrapping tuition for Welsh students to fight the brain drain at its heart.
- Universal free school meals including during holidays, no child should ever go hungry.

CLOSING REMARKS:

This document has no frills, no bells, no whistles, just policy and a cabinet. We don't need fancy graphics to show our commitment to Wales, we only need policy and a cabinet. Everything in this programme is here not because it is eye-catching, or because it's good for sound bytes, but because it's achievable with the little time we have left. Our government will be decisive, strong and efficient. Make no mistake, I do not serve a party, I serve the people, and I have incredibly high standards. If I feel that a minister is not doing their job properly they will be removed from their post and replaced with someone that will do the job, because that is what the people of our nation deserve.
