#### **Airport**

The closest airport is Bradley International. It is served by most major airlines and is located about 35 miles south of Northampton near Hartford, Connecticut. Flying into Bradley rather than to Boston's Logan Airport gives you a shorter drive to Northampton and spares you city traffic congestion.

Limousines, buses and rental cars are available at the airport.

#### Bus

<u>Peter Pan Lines</u> offers intercity service to Northampton at the Peter Pan Terminal, 1 Roundhouse Plaza Suite 2. <u>Greyhound Lines</u> offers through-booking with Peter Pan plus a direct service of its own.

#### Rail

The nearest Amtrak station is across the river in Amherst, Massachusetts. Amherst (AMM) is at 13 Railroad Street, Amherst, MA 01002. It sees a single daily train: the *Vermonter*, which operates from Washington, D.C. to St. Albans, Vermont via New York City.

Additional service is available at Springfield, Massachusetts (SPG), which is 20 miles south of Northampton. Springfield has seven daily round-trips to New Haven, Connecticut, with connections available to other services. There is also a single east-west train, the *Lake Shore Limited*, which operates between Boston and Albany with service west to Chicago. Bus connections are available from Peter Pan and other carriers.

#### **Driving & Parking**

**From the South:** Northampton is on Route I-91 in Massachusetts. Take Exit 18, and follow Route 5 north into the center of town. Turn left onto Route 9. Go straight through four traffic lights, turning left into Smith's main entrance (College Lane) shortly after the fourth set. The Office of Admission is on your right, overlooking Paradise Pond.

**From the North:** From I-91 South, take Exit 20, and follow onto Route 5 south into the center of town. At the intersection of Route 5 and Route 9 (Main Street), turn right onto Route 9. Then follow the same directions as above from Route 9 to campus.

From the East or West via the Massachusetts Turnpike: Northampton is on Route I-91 North (Mass Pike exit 4). Once on I-91, follow the directions above for visitors from the south.

**Parking:** If you plan to park on campus **you will need a parking pass**. Please let us know well in advance so that we can make arrangements.

# Lodging

Attendees are responsible for arranging their own lodging. We have reserved a block of 6 rooms at the Autumn Inn, which is within walking distance of the college. These are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
