Evangelism 101:

Becoming Fishers of Men Spring 2024

Course Description

The intention of this course is to equip the saints to faithfully share the Gospel and to start them on the journey of lifelong evangelism. It begins with the **heart** of evangelism, walks through various **approaches** to evangelism, provides some **overarching principles** in thinking about evangelism, then presents a **Gospel outline** for evangelism. However, we are called not just to speak the truth but to speak the truth in love. So in addition to a basic Gospel outline, the course will also provide **"fishing principles"** to help us understand *how* we should deliver truth.

Class Content:

January 21 - Evangelism Overview

This class will cover what evangelism means, the heart behind evangelism, different approaches to evangelism, and some overarching principles to evangelism.

January 28; February 4, 11 - Gospel Outline

These classes will cover a basic outline for sharing the Gospel and provide some wisdom for how to do it.

Homework: Memorize the five key verses for the Gospel outline, and practice them!

February 25 - Evangelism Skit

This class we will perform a live skit of sharing the Gospel!

Homework: In your EV p a irs, share with someone (two people total) who has been coming to church and fill out a summary!

March 17 - Sharing the Gospel Inside the Church

This class we will reconvene after you have shared with someone who has been coming to our church and discuss a few experiences.

Homework: Homework: In your EV pairs, share with someone (two people total) who hasn't been to church and fill out a summary!

April 14 - Sharing the Gospel Outside the Church

This class we will reconvene again and discuss experiences.
