

Abingdon Vale Cricket Club

Rules of the Site

The site is an active Cricket Club and during the cricket season (April – September) cricket (and/or coaching) takes place on almost all days. Users of the site stay at their own risk and the Club takes no responsibility for any injury or damage caused to any person, vehicle or possessions.

- Rally users do not have exclusive right to the site members of the cricket club (and their families) have the right to use the club facilities whenever they require. This includes, but is not limited to, the use of the ground, nets and parking facilities.
- By arrangement, marshals are allowed to arrive the day prior to the rally if required. This should be arranged at the time of booking.
- A tap for fresh drinking water is located at the corner of the Abingdon Town Football Club.
 Please do not leave it switched on as our water is metered. It is not intended as a play area for children.
- An Elsan emptying point is situated to the left of the pavilion with water for rinsing being available from the tap on the front of the Pavilion. Please use a jug or bottle to obtain rinsing water rather than rinse the Elsan container directly from the tap. Do not empty wet wipes/cloths or other articles into the Elsan point. Failure to comply will result in blockages the costs to clear blockages caused by such misuse will be recharged to the appropriate group.
- Rubbish may be disposed of in the large bins behind the umpires' room please separate your rubbish into recycling and general. Do not leave rubbish outside the caravans or by the bins as this attracts rats.
- Appropriate signs may be erected as required.
- Marshalls will be provided with a key please ensure the gate to the site is locked each evening.
- If you have a dog, feel free to let it off the lead but please clean up after it. Please note this ground is a public right of way and walkers and dog owners are entitled to use the ground. Dog walkers cannot be forced to put their dogs on a lead.
- For those rallies which use the 2nd cricket pitch the cleaning of BBQs on the grass is forbidden as it can damage the outfield.
- Payment must be made on the last day of the rally it can be made by cash, bank transfer or cheque - in the event that a member of AVCC is unable to collect payment, users are requested to post the payment into the lockable post box on the front door of the Pavilion. A receipt for payment will be sent when requested.
