The submitted journal manuscript is the outcome of research and has a maximum page limit of 15 pages. Use proper English, and italicize any foreign terms in the text. A4 paper size (21 x 29.7 cm) with margins of 3 cm on the top, 3 cm on the left, 2 cm on the bottom, and 2 cm on the right.

The contents of the introduction reveal the background of the research problem, the research gap, which is then arranged in the form of a problem formulation, differences from previous research that give rise to the novelty of the research, the purpose of the writing, the hopes to be achieved from the writing, and the scientific benefits of the writing.

Write the title of the introduction, literature review, research methods, results and discussion, conclusions and suggestions, as well as the bibliography using TNR 13 bold, capital letters with 6 pt spacing below. The content of the article uses normal TNR 11, straight left and right margins, and 0 pt top and bottom spacing. The spacing between lines in writing is 1.

## LITERATURE REVIEW

In this section, the author presents a review of the literature, both theoretically and empirically, used in carrying out research. If necessary, the author can write a research hypothesis. Authors can also include a research model or framework in this section.

## RESEARCH METHODS

The research methods that the author must convey include: type of research, research time, source and type of data, data collection techniques, population and sample determination, as well as the analytical tools used.

## RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The contents of the results and discussion reveal research findings based on field data obtained through questionnaires, surveys, documents, *interviews*, observations, and other data collection techniques. The research results are analyzed by interpreting using certain techniques and synthesizing using certain theories (which can also come from the author's thoughts). Research results must be concise and clear.

In more detail in the discussion section, the author must carry out an in-depth analysis of the research results. Avoid repeating what has been said previously in the results section.

This section can be supplemented with tables or figures to provide further explanation. The text and table number are placed at the top with normal TNR 11 letters, center aligned, and top and bottom spacing of 6 pt. The table numbering is in the order in which they appear in the article. Table lines are simply horizontal lines at the beginning and end of the table; delete vertical lines and horizontal lines in the middle of the table.

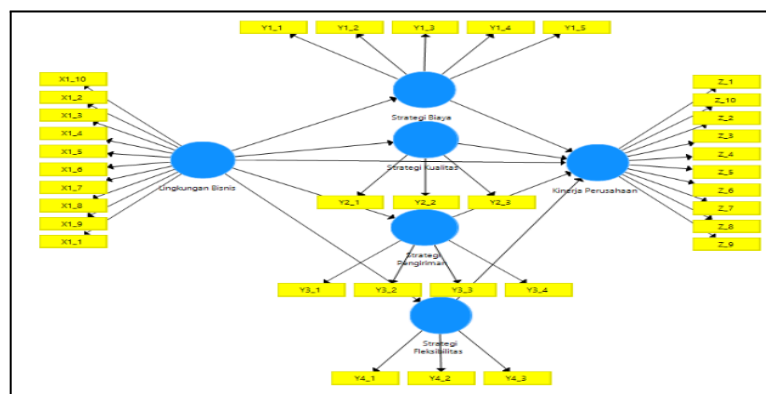


Figure 1. Image title

## BIBLIOGRAPHY

References are arranged **alphabetically** based on the author's last name. References are sourced from journal articles from a maximum of **the last 5 years**. All references cited in this paper must appear in the bibliography. The minimum number of references used is 15 references.

The reference writing format follows APA Style 6th Edition (TNR 11 letters, 1 space, 6pt bottom space) and must use reference management tools (**Zotero or Mendeley**).

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
