GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Instructs and teaches the fundamentals and skills needed to play the game of basketball. Responsible for the children on his/her team and the organization of team practices. Responsible for providing a safe and comfortable environment for members of the team as well as offering a positive experience. Serves as a role model for good sportsmanship and provides leadership to all young athletes.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the direction of the Hillsborough Recreation Director. General direction is also received from the game-day gym supervisors and, if needed, the officials.

ILLUSTRATED DUTIES

- Oversees and manages the players that are assigned to him/her. This includes never leaving a child alone after a practice or game. You must stay with them until their ride arrives.
- Provides a safe environment for all players.
- Responsible for teaching the basic fundamentals and skills needed to play basketball as well as sportsmanship. You will receive a skills/drills guide which will assist you in mapping out your practices.
- Sets up and attends all team practices. If you have a conflict, you find a replacement coach or cancel.
- Communicates all information regarding the basketball program to players and their parents. This includes
 cancellations, practice days and times, schedule updates and any important items handed down from the
 Recreation Director.
- Works supportively and respectfully with Recreation Department officials, site supervisors, officials, parents and other coaches.
- Responsible for any equipment provided to the team (includes but not limited to jerseys and basketballs).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS*

- Ability to work well and communicate with children on a one-to-one basis as well as in a group.
- Must be able to display a positive attitude at all times.
- Competent leadership qualities and skills
- Enthusiastic, energetic, patient, happy, and friendly.
- Ability to establish and maintain an effective working relationship with staff, children, and parents
- Application and Fingerprint clearance on file
- Attends the Coaches Meeting scheduled for Wednesday, November 10, 2021
- Must be COVID-19 Vaccinated per HCSD's Volunteer Requirements

As a volunteer coach, you are treated by local, state, and federal law as being an unpaid employee of the agency with which you are associated; therefore you must conduct yourself in the same manner as you would at your own job. In the same respect, you will receive the same treatment, aside from compensation and benefits, as the employees of the Hillsborough Recreation Department.

*Notice that the minimum qualifications don't require a basketball background. Obviously having some basketball coaching background is ideal, but we've found that if our coaches have these qualities, it is an enjoyable experience for all regardless of their knowledge of basketball.
