IV. Information

A. The Academic Master Plan.

- i. Mentioned at last mtg has not been run by Senate because Chair Council has revised it, and this is the cause of the delay getting to Faculty Senate

B. Shared Governance

- i. Cabinet meets without FSP or FSP-elect contrary to the College Plan
- ii. Kory continues to advocate for presence on the Cabinet, and continues to attempt to build relationship and communication.

C. PC FA Membership.

- i. Kory checked all Senators had/have received verification of current FA membership
- ii. Do not use district resources to provide reminders for annual renewals
- iii. Belonging to the Faculty Association is choosing to belong to a professional advocacy organization

D. HCM debacle update.

- i. Mr. Hibbs has indicated he would expect faculty to go to the Chancellor for his removal should HCM not show progressive improvements
- ii. Document to identify last two pay periods with an explanatory letter specific to individual checks.

- iv. Challenges remain:

F. Course Fees

- i. Kory reviewed her thoughts from FAS discussions that course fees for equipment only can be used for items which can be consumed by the students; however, the DO is discussing how to divide the appropriations of the \$2M of funds to each college's budget which is on-hand.
- ii. This is not a course fee discussion on all fees, only on equipment 250 funds.
- iii. There is going to be money appropriated but the path from the DO to the chairs at each campus is not clear.
