

## 7D7N EAST EUROPE (2TOGO)

## CZECHIA – SLOVAKIA – HUNGARY – AUSTRIA – SWITZERLAND – GERMANY

**Day1 [Fridays] Vienna (270 km) → Mondsee (167 km) → Munich**

We will visit another Austrian gem, Mondsee, a town located on the shore of the crescent-shaped **Mondsee Lake**. It's one the site used to film "The Sound of Music", a world-famous musical. The wedding scene was filmed at the church **Basilica St Michael**. Next, we will arrive Munich in Germany and visit **Marienplatz** (Mary's Square), a central square in the city centre since 1158. You can enjoy some German beer in one of the beerhalls before heading to hotel. Overnight in Munich / nearby city

**Day2 [Saturdays] Munich (400 km) → Mount Titlis (35 km) → Lucerne (53 km) → Zurich**

We'll head to **Engelberg**, a Swiss resort in central Switzerland. You can take a 45-minute cable car ride to get to the summit of **Titlis mountain**. Discover the **Glacier Cave** and go for **Titlis Cliff Walk**, the highlight of the Swiss Alps at a height of 10.000 feet (3000 meters), open-air walkway. Enjoy 360° panorama view of the countless mountain peaks all around you. After lunch, we'll visit Lucerne, a picturesque lakeside city. See the **Lion Monument**, wander around its charming street and get souvenirs like Swiss watches and fine chocolates before making our way to Zurich. (Note: If time allows, we might have a quick stopover at Vaduz, the capital city of Liechtenstein; Not a guaranteed activity, depends on the schedule of the day); Overnight in Zurich / nearby city

**Day3 [Sundays] Zurich (47 km) → Rhine Falls (67 km) → Titisee (303 km) → Frankfurt**

We'll start with a tour in Zurich, the capital city of Switzerland & one of the world's largest financial centres. Take some pictures while we pass by **Lake Zurich** and head to the **Rhine Falls**, the biggest waterfall in Europe. Next we'll drive to Germany and pass through the Black Forest. It gets its name from the canopy of evergreens looming above the forest floor. We will see **Titisee Lake** and visit a **cuckoo clock factory** to see the manufacturing tradition existed for centuries. Get some German pork knuckle for lunch or some black forest cake to mark a sweet note of this trip before going back to Frankfurt. Overnight in Frankfurt / nearby city

**Day4 [Mondays] Frankfurt (510 km) → Prague**

After boarding the luxury coach in Frankfurt, sit back and enjoy a scenic ride through the classic German country side en-route to Czech Republic. The first destination is its capital city Prague, the jewel in the crown of central Europe. It's also called "the golden city", you will see the sandstone towers shimmering in golden tones under the sun as we arrive in early evening. Then head to the hotel for a rest and we'll discover this charming city on the next day; Overnight in Prague / nearby city

**Day5 [Tuesdays] Prague (328 km) → Bratislava**

The Prague adventure begins with a visit to **Prague Castle**, once the home of Bohemia's kings, Czech Republic's President's official residence today. We will visit several attractions inside the castle including: **St. Vitus Cathedral**, the **Golden Lane** which was derived from the goldsmiths who used to live there in the 16th century. Next we will cross the iconic **Charles Bridge** to enjoy the spectacular view over the River Vltava and stop by **Old Town Square**, the most significant historical square in Prague. Then visit the early 15th-century **Astronomical Clock**. Each hour, it springs to life as the 12 Apostles appear and parade in procession across the clock face. Finally we make our way to Hungary & stay over in Bratislava; Overnight in Bratislava / nearby city

**Day6 [Wednesdays] Bratislava (200 km) → Budapest**

We'll spend the day visiting Budapest, the capital city of Hungary. The Danube River runs right through the center of Budapest, dividing the city into two parts, Buda on the west and Pest on the east. Also known as the Pearl of the Danube & the Paris of the East. We'll visit: **The Heroes' Square**, **Budapest Parliament**, **Elizabeth Bridge**, **Fisherman's Bastion**, **Matthias Church** where coronations were taken place, and the panoramic view from the **Liberty Statue** on Gellért Hill. If time allows, you can opt for a Donau river cruise to enjoy the city scenery of Budapest's grand architecture and other landmark located along the river; Overnight in Budapest / nearby city

**Day7 [Thursdays] Budapest (243 km) → Vienna**

Today we'll visit Vienna, the capital of Austria. We'll discover the **Schönbrunn Palace**. This Rococo-style palace was a former imperial summer residence of the Habsburg rulers. Empress Maria Theresa, rebuilt it in the style that appears today. Next, visit Ringstrasse to see: the **City Hall, Hofburg Imperial Palace, Heroes' Square, the Austrian Parliament, and Vienna State Opera**. A trip to Vienna wouldn't be complete without visiting the **gilded bronze statue of Johann Strauss II**, the King of the Waltz. Other "must see" attractions includes **St. Stephen's Cathedral** and the **shopping street**; Overnight in Vienna / nearby city ([Optional: Complement your visit at "Capital of Music" with a Viennese waltz concert](#))
