### **Lakeside Chautauqua Model for the Classroom 2023: 2 Credit Hours**

The Ohio Department of Education Framework Description for the Ohio Fine Arts Learning Standards includes the five content of historical, cultural and social contexts; creative expression and communication; analyzing and responding; valuing the arts/aesthetic reflection, and connections, relationships and applications fundamental to learning and emphasized in the arts. The Ohio Department of Education standards identify three cognitive and creative learning processes in the fine arts and academic

content areas. : These processes include perceiving/knowing/creating (observe, listen, attend to, discriminate), producing/performing ( generate, create, realize, use and master skills) and responding/reflecting (looking back at the experience, information to develop deeper understanding of significance and depth of meaning. Types of higher-level thinking that is included in this course for reflective process will include analysis, synthesis and evaluation. This course is designed to provide access for the educator to utilize Ohio's Department of Education Framework instructional strategies for the Fine Arts that recognize cognitive and creative processes for instruction. Participants will attend programs of their choice at Lakeside Chautauqua that offer the content of the five standards goals (i.e. historical, cultural and social contexts; etc.) Participants will be able to utilize the Framework of the Fine Arts and incorporate them into their lessons for contextual learning. Participants will identify and embody the arts discipline knowledge, skills, and dispositions that should direct students' efforts and learning at their respective grade and developmental level. Participants will be able to use their experiences for creating environments, learning experience and assessments that help their students achieve in the fine arts or the participant's curricula content area for Grades K-5 or 6-12. Participants will create an aligned lesson using their respective Content Learning standards. The program instruction and performances provide participants with academic, content lectured themed series, and production/performances of the fine arts. Programs encompass the Ohio Standard goals for historical, cultural and social contexts; creative expression and communication, analyzing and responding.

Lakeside Chautauqua schedules live events and performances from various musical genres, dance, symphonic music, magicians, comedy and others that explore the world first hand through the diverse cultural arts.
