Guidelines for Performance Art

For the purposes of this show, performance art includes performances such as music (playing an instrument or singing), dance, acting, clowning, puppetry, magic, etc.

Performances may be individual or as a group.

Performances will be scheduled for 8PM - 10PM, the night of the Artists' Reception on Saturday, June 17th.

Each performance is limited to approximately five minutes in part depending on the number of participants overall. Families with multiple children interested in performing might consider entering as a group.

Each artist/group must notify us of the equipment required for their performance. We will do our best to accommodate your needs, however, if we can't provide the equipment you may be asked to supply the equipment yourself.

Performers need to come to the gallery when visual art is scheduled for drop-off (Saturday, June 3rd from 12 - 3PM). At this time, performers must drop off any music, recorded sound, or other supplies needed for their performances. I will email the final show schedule. They will also have the opportunity to view the performance space to ensure that we will have available the space and equipment to support their performances.

There will be around 20 openings for performances.

When selecting performances, we will consider:

1) Date of entry (The earlier the RSVP, the more likely to be selected) 2) Limiting performances to one or two per family 3) Selecting a variety of performances 4) Ease of setup and break down during the show.
