

Medical Team SOP

Joining The Medical Team

- I. Becoming a Medic (68W)
 - A. Must have
 - 1. Hold rank of PFC or higher
 - B. Must have
 - 1. A minimum 75% attendance rate for 1 month
 - C. Successfully completed the basic medical course
 - 1. This is it's own course, separate from OSUT
 - D. Must have
 - 1. Platoon Leader's/Supervisor's permission
 - 2. Medical Team Leader's (MTL) permission
 - 3. Open spot in Medical Team roster
 - II. Training as a Medic (68W)
 - A. Will be conducted by a Platoon Medic
 - 1. Platoon Medic must have acting MTL permission to conduct training.
 - B. Once Section (A) is completed, Trainee will
 - 1. Assist in medical operations with either
 - a) Medical Team Lead
 - b) Platoon Medic
 - C. Once Section (B) is completed (May take about 1 or 2 weeks worth of operations), Trainee will
 - 1. Be assigned to a position within the company
 - a) Positions are subject to change
 - 2. Be Identified as a Medical Team Member
 - III. 160th SOAR Medical Evacuation Specialist SOP
 - I. Becoming a Medical Evacuation Specialist
 - A. Have at least 30 days TIS
 - 1. Additional Prerequisite is that the applicant must have at least 4 Official unit events attended.
 - B. Permission of both MTL, and 160th SOAR CO
 - II. Training as a Medical Evacuation Specialist
 - A. Applicant will then be trained by the company medical team
 - B. Applicant will be trained by the 160th SOAR
 - 1. Applicant will learn to operate areal medical TTPs

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Medical Duties

Positional Duties

Primary Company Medic	Works as supervising Medic in the company, hand out assignments. Acts as Command Section Medic.
Secondary Company Medic	Assistant Company medic.
Platoon Medic	Supervising Medic in Platoon. Normally one of the more senior medics.
Squad CLS	Insert duties
160th SOAR MedEvac Specialist	Medic working with 160th, trained to treat casualties inside aircraft.

Tailored MEDEVAC 9-Line (7-Line)

- Teach the following Transmission Template;

- Line 1: Grid Location
 - Preferably an open area, for a fast and low approach.
 - Use the Freq of the highest ranking
- Line 2: Frequency and Callsign
 - Medical Team Freq: 68
- Line 3: Number of patients by Type
 - **Routine(Charlie)**: (Green Triage Card)(Injuries that are not life threatening but could become)
 - **Priority(Bravo)**: (Yellow Triage Card) (patient requires regular medical care)(Stabilized)
 - **Immediate(Alpha)**: (RED Triage card)(Needs MEDEVAC ASAP)
 - ****Only Call in for Immediate and Priority****
- Line 4: Special Equipment
 - None
 - Body Bags
- Line 5: Patient Movement Status
 - Ambulatory **(Alpha)**: (Can move to MEDEVAC)
 - Litter **(Lima)**: (Cannot Self move)
- Line 6: Area Security
 - No enemy in area **(Alpha)**
 - Possible Enemy Troops **(Bravo)**
 - Enemy Troops in area **(Charlie)**
- Line 7: Method of Marking at pickup site
 - Pyrotechnical equipment- Flare
 - Smoke signal*
 - Other- i.e. IR flash or beacon

This report should include your medical supply status, and any WIA/KIA reports to your senior medic.

A color coded system is used to report back:

- **Green** (Above 50%)
- **Yellow** (<50%)
- **RED** (<25%)
- **BLACK** (Empty)
