What Should I Say To Them?

Here's some ideas:

- Send them to the **website** to learn more about Lifeonaire
 - Tell them to check out the free resources that are available
- Give them a **copy of the Lifeonaire book**
- Share **your personal story**: What breakthroughs, epiphanies, or transformations did you experience?
- Talk about the **energy and impact** of being in the room with other driven, positive people.
- Paint a vivid picture of how **your life and/or business changed** after attending.
- Mention Lifeonaire's **10,000+ past attendees** and **zero money-back guarantee requests** — a powerful sign of the event's impact.
- If you know a particular challenge they're facing, **connect the dots** between that and what they'll learn at the event.

👉 In summary, you just need to show them how they'll benefit , why it's important to be there, and what's at stake if they don't attend.



IMPORTANT

When inviting someone, avoid saying, "It's free."

Instead, say **"I'm sponsoring you"** or **"I'll cover the cost for you."**

Why?

People often devalue "free" things. We want your guest to **understand the true value** of what they're receiving — and show up fully committed.

Who Should I Sponsor?

While there's currently **no limit** on how many guests you can sponsor, we encourage you to use some discretion. We ask that you're on a first-name basis with them and know enough about them to see their potential.

This could be a family member, gym or church buddy, work colleague, or anyone else that meets the following criteria:

The ideal guest is:

- Open-minded and willing to grow
- Positive (or at least willing to become more positive!)
- Ready for change — even if they're scared
- Invested in creating a better life or business

Avoid sponsoring:

- People who aren't coachable
- Chronic complainers, cynics, or "victim mindset" individuals
- Those unwilling to invest time, energy, or effort into themselves

Special Note for Couples and Business Partners:

For couples, we'd **strongly encourage** you to have both spouses attend if it's the Get-A-Life Getaway, and ideally any partners in business for the Business Builder Workshop. In both cases it's extremely important for all parties to be aligned.

FAQ

Q: Do I need to attend the event with my sponsored guest?

A: No, you don't. Sometimes it's helpful for you to be there for support. Other times, your guest might open up more if you're not there. Use your judgment.

Q: What if my guest can't make it?

A: No worries! Please have them let us know by emailing events@lifeonaire.com — ideally with **at least 72 hours' notice**. It's important that our attendee count is accurate because it influences everything from the room size, setup, workbooks and materials we need, etc.

Q: Can we switch events if needed?

A: Yes! Just email events@lifeonaire.com and we'll help you transfer to another event.

Q: Can we (myself and/or my sponsored guests) just show up at the door without registering?

A: This is a terrible idea — please register in advance. We'd hate for you to show up and not have a seat or an event workbook because we didn't know you were coming. If you see an event is sold out and you'd like to be added to the waitlist, email us at events@lifeonaire.com and we might be able to get you in.

Q: How do I get hotel or event location details?

A: After registering, you'll receive an email with all the information. Need it sooner? Contact events@lifeonaire.com.

Q: *Can I sponsor guests to attend both virtual and in-person events?*

A: Absolutely. Both event types are eligible.

Q: Can I sponsor someone who has already attended an event?

A: Yes! If they want to come again, that's awesome.

Q: Who should I contact if I have questions?
