Attention sophomores and juniors who are registered to take the PSAT this Saturday, October 12th - please see important test day information below. BEFORE test day:

- 1. Please check to ensure that you have the Bluebook app on your chromebook. You must be signed OUT of your chromebook to find this app.
- 2. During exam setup, right before the test, you'll have the chance to confirm your personal information and you'll be required to review and agree to the PSAT/NMSQT Testing Rules. It's important to confirm your personal information is correct after you log in to the testing application with your sign-in ticket. If your information is incorrect or you received someone else's sign-in ticket, tell school staff immediately.

# **Test Day Information**

1. Be there by 7:40..no students are allowed to test after 8:05

All the students should be all set with their bluebook app. Students are sent up to the testing rooms by 7:50. No student is allowed in the testing room after 8:05.

- 2. Bring either a student ID or a regular ID.
- 3. Make sure chromebooks are charged!!
- 4. No food or drinks allowed in the testing room. You may bring a snack and water to have during your break.

### **Accessing School:**

- Students will access the school through the Main Entrance.
  - o School doors will open for students at 7:30AM
  - Breakfast will be provided from 7:30AM 8:15AM

## **Driving / Drop Off / Walking:**

Visible personnel in Yellow Construction Vests as well as officers from the Stoneham Police Department will be present to direct vehicles for parking and student drop off. A digital display will also be visible as you drive up the driveway to communicate driving / parking instructions as described below.

- **Student Parking**: All student parking is in the lower lot. Parking attendants will direct students to spaces
- **Drop Off:** Drop off route is along the lower parking lot as in the past year and then coming back up towards the school. Student drop off may occur at any spot along the walkway on your right.
- **Bikes / EV bikes / scooters:** Rules of the road apply, pedestrians have right of way on walkways. Do not ride on any landscaped areas
